- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the Maryland Department of the Environment from
- issuing a permit to construct, reconstruct, or change certain devices, structures, 4
- 5 or apparatus that facilitate the removal of water from off shore of the Potomac
- 6 River; making certain stylistic changes; and generally relating to water removal
- from the Potomac River. 7
- BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, 8

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 15 **Article - Environment**

16 5-504.

- 17 (A) A person shall obtain a permit from the Department to construct, (1)
- 18 reconstruct, change, or make an addition to any conduit, pipeline, wire cable, trestle,
- 19 or other device, structure, or apparatus in, under, through, or over the bed or waters
- 20 of the Potomac River.
- 21 The permit is obtained upon written application to the Department.
- 22 Obtaining, using, and holding this permit is subject severally to the provisions
- 23 concerning permits found elsewhere in this subtitle.
- THE DEPARTMENT MAY NOT ISSUE A PERMIT TO CONSTRUCT, 24 (B)
- 25 RECONSTRUCT, CHANGE, OR MAKE AN ADDITION TO ANY CONDUIT, INTAKE PIPE,
- 26 WIRE CABLE, TRESTLE, OR OTHER DEVICE, STRUCTURE, OR APPARATUS THAT WILL
- 27 FACILITATE THE REMOVAL OF WATER FROM OFF SHORE OF THE POTOMAC RIVER.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 October 1, 1998.
