A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Assisted Living Programs - Small Facilities

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting, before a certain date, the Secretary of Health and

- 4 Mental Hygiene from implementing or enforcing the provisions of Chapter 147
- 5 of the Acts of 1996, relating to assisted living programs, or any regulations
- 6 adopted under Chapter 147 of 1996, with respect to assisted living programs
- 7 that provide services to a certain number of or fewer individuals unless certain
- 8 circumstances have occurred; and relating generally to assisted living programs.

9 Preamble

- WHEREAS, When Chapter 147 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1996
- 11 was enacted to require the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene (DHMH) to be
- 12 the lead agency for regulating assisted living programs, Section 2 of the Act, an
- 13 uncodified provision, required the Department, with the approval of the Department
- 14 of Human Resources and the Office on Aging, to adopt regulations for the operation
- 15 and licensing of assisted living programs according to the level of services provided by
- 16 the programs; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Under the 1996 Act, the deadline for DHMH to adopt the
- 18 regulations was October 1, 1997, a deadline that was finally met on February 3, 1998;
- 19 and
- WHEREAS, The General Assembly declares that Assisted Living Programs
- 21 providing services to eight or fewer individuals require additional time, resources,
- 22 and technical assistance in order to come into compliance with the new regulations
- 23 adopted by DHMH, now, therefore,
- 24 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 25 MARYLAND, That, notwithstanding any provision of Chapter 147 of the Acts of the
- 26 General Assembly of 1996, the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene, prior to July
- 27 1, 1999, may not implement or enforce any provision of that Act, or any regulation
- 28 adopted under it, with respect to an assisted living program, as defined in § 19-801 of
- 29 the Health General Article, that provides services to eight or fewer individuals,
- 30 unless the actions of an assisted living program that provides services to eight or
- 31 fewer individuals have: (1) caused actual physical or emotional harm to a resident in

- $1\,$ the program; or (2) placed a resident in the program at serious risk of physical or $2\,$ emotional harm.
- 3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 4 effect June 1, 1998.
