3 FOR the purpose of requiring a county or municipal corporation to submit to a

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 38A - Fires and Investigations

(A) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, A COUNTY OR
MUNICIPAL CORPORATION MAY NOT PRIVATIZE FIRE, EMERGENCY MEDICAL,
PARAMEDIC, OR RESCUE SERVICE UNLESS AN ENACTMENT PRIVATIZING THE
SERVICES HAS BEEN SUBMITTED TO THE VOTERS OF THE COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL
CORPORATION AT A REFERENDUM HELD AT A GENERAL OR SPECIAL ELECTION.

24 (B) (1) THE COST OF THE REFERENDUM, IF ANY, SHALL BE PAID BY THE 25 GOVERNING BODY OF THE COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION.

26 (2) THE GOVERNING BODY AND THE APPROPRIATE BOARD OF
27 SUPERVISORS OF ELECTIONS OR MUNICIPAL ELECTION OFFICIAL SHALL DO THOSE
28 THINGS NECESSARY AND PROPER TO PROVIDE FOR AND HOLD THE REFERENDUM.

(3) IF A MAJORITY OF THE VOTES CAST ON THE QUESTION ARE "FOR
 THE REFERRED LAW", THE ENACTMENT MAY BECOME EFFECTIVE ON THE DATE
 SPECIFIED IN THE ENACTMENT, BUT IF A MAJORITY OF THE VOTES CAST ON THE
 QUESTION ARE "AGAINST THE REFERRED LAW", THE PROVISIONS OF THE
 ENACTMENT ARE OF NO EFFECT AND NULL AND VOID.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 July 1, 1998.
