- 2 Creation of a State Debt Dorchester County City of Cambridge Liberty
 3 Village Empowerment Center
- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$299,300,
- 5 the proceeds to be used as a grant to the City of Cambridge for certain
- 6 acquisition, development, or improvement purposes; providing for disbursement
- of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and
- 8 expend a matching fund; and providing generally for the issuance and sale of
- 9 bonds evidencing the loan.

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 11 MARYLAND, That:
- 12 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 13 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Dorchester
- 14 County City of Cambridge Liberty Village Empowerment Center Loan of 1998 in
- 15 a total principal amount equal to the lesser of (i) \$299,300 or (ii) the amount of the
- 16 matching fund provided in accordance with Section 1(5) below. This loan shall be
- 17 evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general obligation bonds
- 18 authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold, and
- 19 delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State Finance and
- 20 Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 21 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as
- 22 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- 23 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 24 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 25 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 26 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then
- 27 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 28 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 29 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the City of Cambridge (referred to
- 30 hereafter in this Act as "the grantee") for the planning, design, construction, and
- 31 capital equipping and furnishing of Phase 2 of Liberty Village, a building to be known

- 1 as the Liberty Village Empowerment Center on the grounds of the Pine Street
- 2 Elementary School in Cambridge, the Center to be used as a facility where people can
- 3 learn of the rich cultural heritage of the area and also to be used as a computer and
- 4 medical educational, training, and retraining center for people in the area.
- 5 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in
- $6\,$ rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and
- 7 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years
- 8 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 9 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
- 10 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a
- 11 matching fund. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either
- 12 directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or
- 13 unappropriated. The fund may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds
- 14 expended prior to the effective date of this Act. In case of any dispute as to the amount
- 15 of the matching fund or what money or assets may qualify as matching funds, the
- 16 Board of Public Works shall determine the matter and the Board's decision is final.
- 17 The grantee has until June 1, 2000, to present evidence satisfactory to the Board of
- 18 Public Works that a matching fund will be provided. If satisfactory evidence is
- 19 presented, the Board shall certify this fact and the amount of the matching fund to
- 20 the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan equal to the amount of the matching
- 21 fund shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act. Any amount of the loan
- 22 in excess of the amount of the matching fund certified by the Board of Public Works
- 23 shall be canceled and be of no further effect.
- 24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 25 June 1, 1998.
