- 22 Secretary shall establish an emissions control program in the State in accordance
- 23 with the federal Clean Air Act.
- 24 (2) The program shall remain in effect only as long as required by federal

- 2 (A) Notwithstanding any [rule or] regulation to the contrary and unless
- 3 otherwise prohibited by federal law, any fire or rescue apparatus or ambulance owned
- 4 or leased by a political subdivision of the State, or by a volunteer fire company, rescue
- 5 squad, or volunteer ambulance company, that is registered as an emergency vehicle as
- 6 defined in § 11-118 of this article, is exempt from mandatory inspections under this
- 7 subtitle.
- 8 (B) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY REGULATION TO THE CONTRARY AND UNLESS
- 9 OTHERWISE PROHIBITED BY FEDERAL LAW, ANY VEHICLE DRIVEN LESS THAN 5,000
- 10 MILES PER YEAR SHALL BE EXEMPT FROM THE INSPECTION AND TESTING
- 11 REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- 12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 13 October 1, 1998.
