

- 14 (a) The Secretary shall collect, index, and safeguard from fire, loss, or damage 15 each certificate of birth, death, and fetal death.
- 16 (b) After registration of a completed [birth, death,] DEATH or fetal death
- 17 certificate, the Secretary shall send a copy of the original certificate to the county
- 18 registrar for the county where the event occurred. The copy may be photographic or
- 19 electronic or produced by other means as prescribed by the Secretary.

- 21 (a) [(1) A county registrar shall preserve each copy of a birth record that the 22 Secretary sends to the county registrar.
