A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Creation of a State Debt - Wicomico County - Drill Academy for Youth

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$725,000,
- 4 the proceeds to be used as a grant to the County Commissioners of Wicomico
- 5 County for certain acquisition, development, or improvement purposes;
- 6 providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that
- 7 the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; and providing generally for
- 8 the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 10 MARYLAND, That:

- 11 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 12 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Wicomico
- 13 County Drill Academy for Youth Loan of 1998 in a total principal amount equal to
- 14 the lesser of (i) \$725,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided in
- 15 accordance with Section 1(5) below. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale,
- 16 and delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board
- 17 of Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through
- 18 8-124 of the State Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 19 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as 20 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- 21 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 22 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 23 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 24 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then
- 25 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 26 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 27 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the County Commissioners of Wicomico
- 28 County (referred to hereafter in this Act as "the grantee") for the planning, design,
- 29 construction, and capital equipping and furnishing of a residential drill academy the

- 1 purpose of which is to retrain the youth of Wicomico County who have been
- 2 recommended for a program at the facility as a result of proceedings within the
- 3 judicial system in Wicomico County.
- 4 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in
- 5 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and
- 6 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years
- 7 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 8 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
- 9 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a
- 10 matching fund. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either
- 11 directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or
- 12 unappropriated. No part of the fund may consist of in kind contributions or funds
- 13 expended prior to the effective date of this Act. The fund may consist of real property.
- 14 In case of any dispute as to the amount of the matching fund or what money or assets
- 15 may qualify as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine the matter
- 16 and the Board's decision is final. The grantee has until June 1, 2000, to present
- 17 evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a matching fund will be
- 18 provided. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact and
- 19 the amount of the matching fund to the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan
- 20 equal to the amount of the matching fund shall be expended for the purposes provided
- 21 in this Act. Any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of the matching fund
- 22 certified by the Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of no further effect.
- 23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 24 June 1, 1998.
