27 28 29 30	(2) A property owner whose project is approved is eligible to receive an interest-free loan covering 100% of the first \$60,000 of project construction cost, 50% of the next \$20,000 of project construction cost, 25% of the next \$20,000 of project construction cost, and 10% of the part of construction cost exceeding \$100,000. However, where 2 or more property owners are included within a shore erosion control project, the land of each property owner is considered a separate shore erosion project for the purpose of computing net project construction cost under this formula.
