2 Consumer Protection - Restocking Fees

- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting merchants from charging a consumer who returns
- 4 merchandise purchased from the merchant a restocking or return fee that
- 5 exceeds certain amounts; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally
- 6 relating to restocking or return fees charged by merchants to consumers.
- 7 BY adding to

- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 14 Article Commercial Law
- 15 13-319.
- 16 A MERCHANT MAY NOT CHARGE A CONSUMER WHO RETURNS MERCHANDISE
- 17 PURCHASED FROM THE MERCHANT A RESTOCKING OR RETURN FEE IN EXCESS OF:
- 18 (1) 10% OF THE PURCHASE PRICE OF THE MERCHANDISE, IF THE
- 19 PURCHASE PRICE OF THE MERCHANDISE IS LESS THAN OR EQUAL TO \$1,000; OR
- 20 \$100, IF THE PURCHASE PRICE OF THE MERCHANDISE IS GREATER
- 21 THAN \$1,000.
- 22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency
- 23 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety,
- 24 has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members
- 25 elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from
- 26 the date it is enacted.
