## Montgomery County - Real Property - Recordation MC 824-98

This bill provides that recordation by the clerk of the circuit court of instruments affecting property may be done prior to the transfer of the property on the assessment records in Montgomery County. It eliminates the requirement that an individual must visit the county property assessment office to have a deed reviewed and stamped before it is recorded by the clerk of the circuit court.
