Commerce and Government Matters

Election Laws - Campaign Reports - Place of Filing

This bill requires candidates for office to file all required reports or statements to the local election board in each political sub-division represented by the office. Current law requires candidates for an office representing more than one political subdivision to file reports and statements with the local election board in the county or city where they reside.

The bill is effective January 1, 1999.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. The bill does not directly affect State operations or finances.

Local Effect: None. Any increase in workload due to additional filings could be handled with existing resources of local boards of election.
