Economic Matters

Maryland Tourism Development Board - Composition

This bill increases the membership of the Maryland Tourism Development Board in the Department of Business and Economic Development from 15 to 17 by adding two members to be appointed from the private sector business community by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Delegates.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: Minimal increase in expenditures. Revenues would not be affected.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: None.

Fiscal Analysis

State Expenditures: Board members serve without compensation, but are entitled to reimbursement in accordance with the standard State travel regulations. Based on actual average reimbursements of current board members, it is estimated that two additional board members would result in total increased expenditures of \$1,320 per year.
