House Bill 700 (Washington County Delegation)
Economic Matters

Washington County - Alcoholic Beverages - Days of Sale

This bill permits Class B and Class C licensees in Washington County to sell alcoholic beverages on Sunday between the hours of 11 a.m. and 12 noon, provided a consumer orders a meal prior to or with the order for the alcoholic beverage or a consumer is entitled to a meal as part of a prearranged event. The bill also permits Class A, Class B, Class C, or Class D on-sale licensees to sell alcoholic beverages from 12 noon on Sunday to 2 a.m. on Monday when a federal holiday falls on a Monday.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: The additional hour of alcoholic beverage sales on Sundays would not directly affect Washington County finances.

Small Business Effect: Minimal impact on small businesses.
