## **Education - Transitioning Youth - Reporting on Postsecondary Service Needs**

This amended bill requires local boards of education to provide information on the postsecondary anticipated services of students with disabilities between the ages of 14 and 21 to the Maryland State Department of Education (MSDE). MSDE must aggregate the information and forward it to the Mental Hygiene Administration, the Developmental Disabilities Administration, and other appropriate State adult services agencies. This bill takes effect July 1, 1998.

## **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** None. The Division of Rehabilitation Services within MSDE is already responsible for developing an Interagency State Plan for Transitioning Students which includes much of the information stipulated in the bill.

**Local Effect:** Indeterminate. Local school systems already collect most of the information required by this bill; however, if MSDE extends reporting requirements beyond what is currently collected local school expenditures could increase.

**Small Business Effect:** None.
