**Economic and Environmental Affairs** 

#### **Child Care Administration Advisory Council - Membership**

This departmental bill increases the membership of the Child Care Administration Advisory Council by mandating a minimum of 25 members and a maximum of 30 members. Current law provides for a minimum of 21 members and a maximum of 25 members. New committee members must include at least one representative each from the Maryland Association of Social Services Directors and a professional organization concerned with early childhood programs and at least two representatives each from family day care providers and child care providers.

# **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** None. Council members are not eligible to receive compensation or reimbursement for expenses.
