Baltimore City Board of School Commissioners - Statutory Deadlines

This emergency bill extends the statutory deadlines for certain actions relating to the New Baltimore City Board of School Commissioners.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: None. Extending the Baltimore City School Board's statutory deadline for complying with certain requirements would not affect city finances.

Small Business Effect: None.

Fiscal Analysis

Background: Pursuant to the Baltimore City School legislation enacted during the 1997 session (Chapter 105 of the Acts of 1997), the Baltimore City Board of School Commissioners have to fulfill certain statutory requirements within a given time period. This bill extends the deadline for four requirements, as shown in **Exhibit 1**.
