Senate Bill 380 (Senator Middleton. *et al.*)

Budget and Taxation

Creation of a State Debt - Charles County - Lions Camp Merrick

This bill provides \$250,000 in State bond proceeds as a grant to the Waldorf Lions Foundation for the planning, design, construction, and capital equipping of a residence and office for the camp administrator and the repair and renovation of other buildings at Lions Camp Merrick.

The Waldorf Lions Foundation must provide matching funds by June 1, 2000. The matching fund may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective date of the bill.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: This \$250,000 grant would be part of the total \$430 million general obligation debt authorization for FY 1999 as recommended by the Capital Debt Affordability Committee. State debt service costs on the \$430 million would be a maximum of \$44.2 million annually based on the 4.34% interest rate realized at the February 18, 1998 bond sale.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: Minimal.
