## Carroll County - Subdivision Approval Process - Required Adequate Facilities Test - Repeal

This bill repeals a provision of current law which mandates a public facilities review as part of the subdivision approval process in Carroll County. There is already a provision of current law which authorizes all counties and Baltimore City to enact ordinances or other laws relating to the planning, staging, and provision of adequate public facilities for subdivisions.
