House Bill 761 (Delegate Nathan-Pulliam)

Environmental Matters

Maryland Electrology Practice Act

This bill authorizes the State Board of Electrologists to disclose information in a record of a licensee or in the board's investigatory file to specified health and law enforcement authorities. The bill also expands the grounds under which the board may discipline a licensee, and authorizes the board to require an examination by a health care provider while investigating an allegation against a licensee. An action may be maintained in the name of the board or the State to enjoin the unauthorized practice of electrology or conduct that is grounds for disciplinary action. The bill makes numerous other changes relating to the powers and duties of the board and procedures for administrative hearings.
