## **Alcoholic Beverages - Wineries - Samples**

This emergency bill authorizes a wine manufacturer with a Class 3 or Class 4 license to serve at no charge up to six ounces of wine made at its facility to a person who is touring that facility, provided the person is of legal drinking in age in Maryland.
