## **Education - Noncertificated Employees - Prohibitions on Hiring**

This bill prohibits a local board of education from hiring an individual as a noncertificated employee if the individual has been convicted of specified crimes. This bill only applies to individuals applying for employment after July 1, 1998.

## **Fiscal Summary**

State Effect: None.

**Local Effect:** Prohibiting local school systems from hiring certain individuals would not affect local expenditures. School officials should be able to fill employment vacancies absent these individuals.
