FISCAL NOTE

Senate Bill 531 (Senators Haines and Ferguson) (Carroll County Senators)

Economic and Environmental Affairs

Carroll County - Board of Education - Compensation

This bill increases the salaries of the members of the Carroll County Board of Education, effective with their next term of office. The chairman's salary is increased from \$2,000 to \$3,500 and members' salaries are increased from \$1,800 to \$3,000.

This bill takes effect July 1, 1998.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Carroll County expenditures would increase by \$2,100 in FY 1999. Revenues would not be affected.

Small Business Effect: None.

Fiscal Analysis

Local Effect: The Carroll County Board of Education has five members elected to four-year terms. Three positions are up for election in 1998, with the remainder occurring in 2000. Due to the staggering of board elections, the financial impact of the bill is spread out over four years with the full impact occurring in fiscal 2002. For fiscal 1999, Carroll County expenditures would increase by \$2,100 (\$1,950 in salaries and \$150 in Social Security taxes). This is based on a \$750 salary increase for the chairman and a \$600 salary increase for two board members). Future expenditure increases are illustrated in **Exhibit 1**.
