Senate Bill 671 (Senators Derr and Ferguson)
(Frederick County Senators)

Economic and Environmental Affairs

Frederick County - Alcoholic Beverages Inspector - Term and Salary

This bill increases, from \$25,000 to \$32,000, the annual salary of the Frederick County alcoholic beverages inspector and increases, from four to five years, the length of the term of office of the inspector. The increase in the length of the term of office applies retroactively so that the term of the incumbent inspector commences on July 1, 1997.

The bill is effective June 1, 1998.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Frederick County expenditures would increase by \$741 for one month in FY 1998, and by \$8,890 in FY 1999 and thereafter. No effect on revenues.

Small Business Effect: None.

Fiscal Analysis

Local Effect: Under existing law, the Frederick County alcoholic beverages inspector's salary is \$25,000 annually. Expenditures would increase by \$741 for one month of fiscal 1998, and \$8,890 in fiscal 1999 and thereafter, which reflects the salary increase and associated fringe benefits for a full year.
