House Bill 42 (Delegate Grosfeld. *et al.*)

Judiciary

Family Law - Award of Expenses

This bill adds absolute divorce, limited divorce, and property disposition in annulment or divorce to the types of proceedings in which a court may award to either party an amount for the "reasonable and necessary expense" of prosecuting or defending the proceeding. The bill specifies what a court must consider before ordering payment and allows a court to order counsel fees to be paid directly to the lawyer.

The bill applies to cases filed on or after the October 1, 1998 effective date.
