Environmental Matters

State Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners - Grounds for Discipline

This departmental bill allows the State Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners to refuse, suspend, or revoke the application or license, and censure or place on probation any licensee after a hearing, if the veterinarian has been disciplined by a licensing authority of another state for any act that would be grounds for discipline under Maryland law.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. The bill's requirements could be handled with existing resources.
