House Bill 802 (Delegate Rosenberg. *et al.*)

Appropriations

Creation of a State Debt - Baltimore City - Police Athletic League Center

This bill provides \$900,000 in State bond proceeds as a grant to the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore for the planning, design, repair, renovation, construction, reconstruction, and capital equipping of a building adjacent to the Reisterstown Road Plaza for use as a Police Athletic League Center.

The Mayor and City Council must provide matching funds by June 1, 2000.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: This \$900,000 grant would be part of the total \$430 million general obligation debt authorization for FY 1999 as recommended by the Capital Debt Affordability Committee. State debt service costs on the \$430 million would be a maximum of \$44.2 million annually based on the 4.34% interest rate realized at the February 18, 1998 bond sale.

Local Effect: Baltimore City grant revenues would increase by \$900,000 and expenditures would increase by \$1.8 million.

Small Business Effect: Minimal.
