Law Enforcement Officers' Bill of Rights - Applicability

This bill expands the definition of "law enforcement officer" as it applies to the Law Enforcement Officers' Bill of Rights by including: (1) police officers of the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene; (2) police officers of the Department of General Services; (3) police officers of the Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation; (4) full-time investigative assistants and inspection assistants in the State Fire Marshal's Office; and (5) all police forces of the Department of Transportation.
