Economic Matters

Frederick County - Alcoholic Beverages - Bottle Clubs

This bill prohibits "bottle clubs" in Frederick County from serving or allowing alcoholic beverages to be consumed after legal closing hours. Violators are subject to a fine not exceeding \$10,000 and/or imprisonment not exceeding two years. The bill also applies the prohibition against nudity and sexual displays to bottle clubs. There are currently no bottle clubs operating in Frederick County.

The bill is effective July 1, 1998.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: The civil/criminal penalty provisions of this bill are not expected to significantly affect State finances or operations.

Local Effect: The civil/criminal penalty provisions of this bill are not expected to significantly affect local finances or operations.
