Economic and Environmental Affairs

Military Department - Assistant Adjutant General for Army and Air

This departmental bill authorizes the assistant adjutant general for Army or the assistant adjutant general for Air to have a commissioned grade above brigadier general if the individual is selected for a military position requiring federal recognition as a major general.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. Altering the grade limitations on the assistant adjutant general for Army and Air does not affect the salary of the position.
