Senate Bill 392 (Senator McFadden)
Economic and Environmental Affairs

Baltimore City - Alcoholic Beverages - Employment of Minors

This bill prohibits an alcoholic beverages licensee in Baltimore City from employing or allowing any person under the age of 18 to sell, serve, or deliver alcoholic beverages, or to provide entertainment on the licensed premises.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: The Baltimore City Board of License Commissioners could monitor licensees with existing resources. No effect on revenues.

Small Business Effect: Minimal impact on small businesses.
