### **Advisory Committee on Home-Based Health Care Services**

This bill requires the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene (DHMH) to establish an Advisory Committee on Home-Based Health Care Services. The committee is to: (1) study the current regulatory framework for home-based health care and recommend whether oversight should be strengthened or streamlined; and (2) examine employment issues relating to liability for paying employment benefits. DHMH is to staff the committee. The committee is to report to the Secretary of DHMH by December 1, 1998 and to the General Assembly by December 31, 1998.

The bill takes effect June 1, 1998.

### **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** None. The bill's requirements could be handled with existing budgeted resources.

Local Effect: None.

# **Fiscal Analysis**

**State Expenditures:** It is assumed that advisory committee members would be eligible for expense reimbursements according to the standard State travel regulations. Expense reimbursements would depend upon the time, location, and frequency of the advisory committee's meetings. It is expected that reimbursements for the governmental members could be handled with the existing resources of the governmental entities represented on the advisory committee. Likewise, reimbursements for the non-governmental members could be
