## Sales and Use Tax - Shipping and Handling Charges

This bill requires the Office of the Comptroller to conduct a study on the sales and taxation of shipping and handling charges on mail-order purchases. The study must include how other states tax shipping and handling charges on mail-order purchases and the current treatment of shipping and handling charges by direct marketers. The report is to be submitted to the House Committee on Ways and Means and the Senate Budget and Taxation Committee by October 15, 1998.

This bill is effective July 1, 1998.
