FISCAL NOTE

House Bill 363 (Montgomery County Delegation)

Appropriations

**Montgomery County - Board of Education - Capital Improvements Program
MC 818-98**

This bill requires the Montgomery County Board of Education to prepare and submit to the county executive a six-year capital improvement program every two-years (before December 1 of each odd-numbered year). The county executive must include the board's program in the comprehensive six-year program submitted each even-numbered calendar year to the Montgomery County Council. Under current law, the county school superintendent must prepare and submit this plan every year. In addition, this legislation enables the county council to amend an approved capital improvement program at any time by an affirmative vote of six council members.

This bill takes effect July 1, 1998.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Changing to a biennial process for preparing and approving the county's six-year school capital improvement program could reduce the workload of county employees; however, it would not directly affect Montgomery County finances.
