Economic Matters

Condominiums - Insurance Coverage - Policy Provisions

This bill requires property and comprehensive general liability insurance policies maintained by the council of unit owners of a condominium to contain provisions providing that in cases of negligence by the unit owner of a property for which there is a loss, the council's policies are secondary.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. The bill would not directly affect State finances or operations.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: Potential minimal effect on small businesses.

Fiscal Analysis

Small Business Effect: This bill shifts exposure from the council of unit owners of a condominium to the unit owner in cases where the unit owner is negligent. Thus, while councils of unit owners may experience a minimal decrease in insurance premiums, unit owners may experience a corresponding increase.
