FISCAL NOTE

House Bill 423 (Delegate T. Murphy)

Environmental Matters

Environmental Permits - Conveyance - Public Hearing

This bill requires the Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE) to follow the same notice and hearing procedures for the conveyance of permits that it does for original permit applications. These procedures include: (1) making applications for conveyance available to the public for inspection and copying; (2) providing the opportunity for an informational meeting upon written request; (3) requiring the conveyance applicant to attend the meeting; and (4) denying the permit conveyance application for failure of the applicant to attend the informational meeting or public or contested case hearing.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. Costs associated with providing public notice and additional informational meetings or public hearings could be handled with MDE's existing resources.

Local Effect: Minimal. Local governments could experience a longer permit transfer process.

Small Business Effect: Minimal. Small businesses could experience a longer permit transfer process.
