House Bill 713 (Charles County Delegation)
Judiciary

Charles County - Sheriff's Salary

This bill provides that the salary of the Charles County Sheriff shall be equal to the salary of a Lieutenant Colonel step L-13 in the Department of State Police, beginning with the next term of office. Under current law, the sheriff's salary is equal to the salary of a Major Step 4 in the Department of State Police. Any change in salary under the State Police pay plan during the term of office of the Charles County Sheriff is not effective until the beginning of the next term of office.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Charles County expenditures would increase by \$6,787 in FY 1999 and \$13,574 annually thereafter. No effect on revenues.

Small Business Effect: None.

Fiscal Analysis

Local Effect: Under current law, the salary of the sheriff in fiscal 1999 will be \$67,092. The bill changes the salary to \$77,951. Expenditures would thus increase by \$6,787 in fiscal 1999, which reflects the salary increase for six months and associated fringe benefits. Beginning in fiscal 2000 and thereafter, expenditures would increase by \$13,574.
