Ways and Means

Education - Students with Disabilities - Review of Services and Placement Decisions of the Office of Administrative Hearings

This bill enables a surrogate parent of a student with disabilities to make a written request to the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) for a review of educational decisions pertaining to the disabled student. Currently, only a parent, guardian, or public agency can file a review request. In addition, the bill requires these requests to be filed within 90 days from the time the public agency makes its decision. The bill also reduces the time period following the final review decision of OAH from 180 to 90 days by which a party to the hearing can file a civil action with the federal or circuit courts. This bill takes effect July 1, 1998.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. Any additional workload for OAH could be handled with existing resources. Other provisions of the bill are procedural in nature and would not directly affect State finances.
