Drunk Driving - Restricted Driving Privilege - Valid Medical Purpose

This bill authorizes the Motor Vehicle Administration (MVA) to modify a suspended license or issue a restricted license to an individual convicted of alcohol or drug related driving offenses if the licensee is required to drive for a valid medical purpose of the licensee or an “immediate family member”.
