## FISCAL NOTE Revised

Senate Bill 363 (Senator Collins)

Licensed Physical Therapists, Licensed Physical Therapist Assistants, and Licensed Chiropractors with Physical Therapy Privileges - Scope of Practice - Topical Pharmaceutical Agents

This bill authorizes a licensed physical therapist, a licensed physical therapist assistant, and a licensed chiropractor with physical therapy privileges to apply a "topical pharmaceutical agent" to the skin in accordance with specified criteria. The licensed physical therapist or licensed physical therapy assistant must: (1) have appropriate documentation in the patient's medical record concerning the application of a topical pharmaceutical agent; and (2) allow the Office of Drug Control of the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to enter and inspect the licensee's office at all reasonable hours. A licensed physical therapist and licensed chiropractor with physical therapy privileges may only procure a topical pharmaceutical agent from a person that holds a distribution permit issued by the State Board of Pharmacy to dispense prescription drugs or devices. A licensed physical therapy assistant may not procure a topical pharmaceutical agent.

The State Board of Physical Therapy Examiners (board), in conjunction with the State Board of Pharmacy and the Board of Physician Quality Assurance (BPQA), must develop a list of topical pharmaceutical agents that may be procured by the above authorized individuals. In addition, the board must adopt regulations concerning the storage and use of topical pharmaceutical agents.
