Judicial Proceedings

Carroll County - Orphans' Court Judges - Salary

This bill increases the annual salary of each judge of the Orphans' Court for Carroll County from \$7,500 to \$10,000.

The salary increases would take effect at the beginning of the next term of office, which is December 1, 1998.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: Minimal increase in general fund expenditures associated with increased retirement contributions.

Local Effect: County expenditures would increase by \$4,710 in FY 1999 and by \$8,074 annually thereafter. No effect on revenues.

Small Business Effect: None.

Fiscal Analysis

State Expenditures: The three judges of the Orphans' Court for Carroll County are part of the State employees' retirement and pension system. As a result of the salary increases provided for by this bill, general fund expenditures for retirement contributions for the judges would increase by less than \$600 per year, based on the fiscal 1999 employer contribution rate of 7.13%.

Local Expenditures: The salaries of the judges of the Orphans' Court for Carroll County are paid with local funds. As a result of this bill, county expenditures would increase by an estimated \$4,710 in fiscal 1999, which reflects total salary increases and related fringe benefits for the last six months of fiscal 1999.

Future year expenditure increases of \$8,074 reflect full year salaries and fringe benefits.
