FISCAL NOTE

House Bill 104 (Howard County Delegation)

Ways and Means

Howard County - Board of Education - Compensation
Ho. Co. 12-98

This bill increases the salaries of the members of the Howard County Board of Education. The chairman's salary is increased from \$10,000 to \$11,000 and the members' salaries are increased from \$9,000 to \$9,900.

This bill takes effect July 1, 1998.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Howard County expenditures would increase by \$4,950 annually beginning in FY 1999. Revenues would not be affected.

Small Business Effect: None.

Fiscal Analysis

Local Effect: The Howard County Board of Education has five members elected for six-year terms. This bill would increase Howard County expenditures by \$4,950 annually (\$4,600 in salaries and \$350 in Social Security taxes) beginning in fiscal 1999.
