Caroline County - Number of County Commissioners - Straw Ballot

This bill requires a question to be placed on the ballot in Caroline County at the November 1998 general election to determine the sense of the voters on the issue of increasing the size of the Board of County Commissioners from three to five members, elected at large from three residence districts.

The bill is effective July 1, 1998.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. The bill would not directly affect State operations or finances.

Local Effect: The Caroline County Board of Supervisors of Elections could place the question on the ballot at the 1998 general election with existing resources. No effect on revenues.
