**Harford County - Alcoholic Beverages - Separate Outside Entrance**

This bill repeals the requirement in Harford County that Class A-1 and A-2 alcoholic beverages licensees must provide a separate outside entrance for off-sale customer use if a majority of the retail sales is not alcoholic beverages.
