Environmental Matters

**Office for Children, Youth, and Families - Services to Children with Disabilities -
Local Coordinating Councils - Membership**

This amended bill increases the membership of each local coordinating council established by the State Coordinating Council in the Office for Children, Youth, and Families to include at least one representative from the local office of the Division of Rehabilitative Services, the Local Management Board, and the local core service agency.
