Criminal Records - Expungement

This bill adds incarcerable vehicle law violations to the types of offenses for which an individual may request expungement of the related police records. Expungement is not precluded if a nonincarcerable vehicle law violation arose out of the same incident.

The bill may not be construed to require the Motor Vehicle Administration (MVA) to expunge a driving record.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. It is expected that any affected State agencies, including the MVA and Department of State Police, could absorb the bill's requirements with current levels of funding, resources, and personnel.

Local Effect: None. It is expected that any affected units of local government, including local law enforcement agencies, could absorb the bill's requirements with current levels of funding, resources, and personnel.

Small Business Effect: None.
