Task Force on Pharmacy Technicians

This bill establishes an eight-member Task Force on Pharmacy Technicians to evaluate: (1) the functions performed by pharmacy technicians, and the extent to which pharmacy technicians should and actually dispense prescription or nonprescription medicine to consumers; (2) the education and training required for employment as a pharmacy technician; (3) the public's perception of pharmacy technicians; and (4) other states' policies and standards regarding pharmacy technicians. The task force must also make recommendations regarding policies and standards for pharmacy technicians in the State. The task force will consist of four members of the House of Delegates and four members of the Senate. The task force must issue a final report of its findings and recommendations to the Governor by December 31, 1998.

The bill takes effect June 1, 1998.
