House Bill 815 (Washington County Delegation)

Commerce and Government Matters

#### **Election Code - Washington County Election Board - Salaries**

This bill increases, beginning with the next term of office, the minimum annual salary of members of the Washington County Board of Supervisors of Elections from \$2,300 to \$2,600 for the President and from \$2,000 to \$2,300 for other members.

### **Fiscal Summary**

State Effect: None.

**Local Effect:** Washington County expenditures would increase by \$450 in FY 1999 reflecting the salary increases for six months, and \$900 annually thereafter. No effect on revenues.

Small Business Effect: None.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

**Local Expenditures:** There are currently three members of the Washington County Board of Supervisors of Elections. Each member would receive a \$300 annual increase in salary, resulting in a \$450 expenditure increase for six months of fiscal 1999. Annual expenditures would increase by \$900 for the salary enhancements.
