House Bill 825 (Prince George's County and Montgomery County Delegations) Appropriations

Montgomery County - MNCPPC - Capital Improvement Program PG/MC 18-98

This bill requires the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission (MNCPPC) to prepare and submit to the Montgomery County Executive a six-year capital improvements program every two years. Under current law, the commission must prepare and submit this plan every year. In addition, this legislation enables the Montgomery County Council to amend an approved six-year capital improvements program at any time by an affirmative vote of six members.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Changing to a biennial process for preparing and approving the commission's six-year capital improvement program could reduce the workload of county employees; however, it would not directly affect MNCPPC or Montgomery County finances.

Small Business Effect: None.
