House Bill 1005 (Delegate Redmer. *et al.*)

Environmental Matters

Consolidated Fishing License - Application

This bill requires the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) to issue a resident consolidated senior sport fishing license beginning in the calendar year in which the applicant attains the age of 65 rather than waiting until the resident's 65th birthday as required under current law.

This bill takes effect June 1, 1998.

Fiscal Summary

Background: In 1997, 18,027 resident consolidated senior sport fishing licenses were sold at a cost of \$5 per license.
