House Bill 1385 (Delegate D. Murphv. *et al.*)

Commerce and Government Matters

Election Law - Baltimore County Republican Party Central Committee

This bill changes the method of electing members of the Republican Party Central Committee in Baltimore County by providing for the election of three members from each county council district and of a chairman from the county at large. Under current law, members of the Republican Central Committee in Baltimore County are elected from legislative or delegate districts.

The bill is effective June 1, 1998.

Local Effect: Changing the method of electing members to the Baltimore County Republican Central Committee would not directly affect Baltimore County finances.
